### Special Person Day - Wednesday 22nd May

Thank you so much for the gifts that have come in over the last week - we are getting closer to our 550 target of gifts. Paper bags have also been distributed this week which the children will be decorating in school in preparation for our Special Person Day. You can now start paying in your £1 per child into our Arbor Payment System - please pay for each child individually (this way we can see exactly who has paid more quickly and easily) under the 'Seely Fundraising' category including "special persons day" in the narrative/comments please. If you do not have the Arbor App children can bring £1 in cash - these should be given to class teachers. Please make these payments by Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May. Thanks

For those of you who don't know, this is a day when our children get the opportunity to say thank you to someone who is very special to them. All children then get the chance to buy an item for £1 to give to someone special in their lives. This could be a mummy, grandad, sister, step dad, foster carer, nan to name just a few. This is a really wonderful day in our calendar and a time when we encourage our children to think about other people around them. We talk to our children in assembly asking them who those very special people are in their lives who looks after them when they are sick, who is there for them when they are sad or scared, who makes them feel special.

They can then visit the 'Special Person' shop which is set up on that day to choose a gift for their Special Person. We hope that all children will be able to participate. If anyone would like to donate more than £1 to enable another child to take part this would be amazing.

We do have a number of gifts already - 300 at present but this is a shout out for items such as toiletries, jewellery, candles, small toys and particularly men's gifts. We charge £1 for a gift so it would be items that are suitable for this price range — or things like toiletry sets which we can separate into several gifts. ### A message from the local PCSO Team

A fourth contactless payment point has been installed in Sherwood as part of a scheme to help people give money in a safe and reliable way to people sleeping rough or facing homelessness in Nottingham.

The Nottingham Street Aid initiative launched in February this year to give people a simple way of donating directly to those in need of support.

The new point has been installed as the number of people sleeping rough has increased by 21 per cent in the city over the last two years, rising from 604 people to 729.

The first contactless payment points were set up in the Victoria Centre and at the Theatre Royal on April 6, while a third was recently installed at McDonald's in Clumber Street.

A fourth payment point has now been installed in Mansfield Road, Sherwood, next to Nibbles, becoming the first point to become operational outside the city centre.

Dr Paul Scotting, who has been coordinating the initiative, says around £600 per month is being raised through the payment points. He said: "We hope the people at Sherwood will take this opportunity to donate £3 per tap to the fund, every penny of which will be spent on items to help someone who is homeless.

"We also provide QR codes for those who would like to donate more or would like to become regular donors."

To donate, people approach the machine, tap their card, and a £3 donation will be made.

It will appear on bank statements as a payment to the Notts Community Foundation, which is one of the partners of the initiative.

The idea for the initiative was inspired by Cambridge Street Aid, Dr Scotting says, and a similar initiative has also been running in Leicester since 2019.

Money donated goes into a fund managed by the Notts Community Foundation, and charities can bid for access to some of the money which must be spent on items for a person who is homeless. Thank you.


You need to design and construct Seely's first animal habitat.
