Family Learning - 19th June - What would you like to do?

We have a Free Family Workshop booked in for Wednesday 19th June 9-11am. Below is details of 5 workshops that are available to be run on this day. We would like to give parents out there the opportunity to choose what subjects would work for them. If you are able to make this day please email me with your choice of which workshop you would like to see happening. I will then choose the one which is more popular. They deal with some tricky issues to support parents in keeping their own and their children's mental health and wellbeing on top form.

- Family Cyberwise Workshop an introduction to helping parents to keep themselves and their children safe online, including setting parental controls, and some particularly useful sites for parents.
- Talking Tough Topics how to prepare your children for the dangers facing teenagers today. We all worry about how well our children will cope with the situations such as online grooming, bullying, gangs, knife crime, County Lines, drugs, gambling and more.
- 5 steps to Mental Wellbeing Evidence suggests there are five steps we can all take to improve our mental wellbeing. During this workshop we will explore ways to improve your own, and your children's mental health by looking at these five things. If you give them a try, you may feel happier, more positive and have the resilience to cope when times are tougher than usual.
- Coping with Anxiety Taster session Helping parents/carers and children understand feelings and manage emotions. Learn what stress is and the different coping strategies to use
- Workshop for Dads come and see what your child has been working on in school and do some fun activities as well.

Now is your chance!


You need to design and construct Seely's first animal habitat.
